



Oklahoma City Chapter 2020 PRSSA Student Scholarship Application

PURPOSE

Chartered in 1947, the Public Relations Society of America (PRSA) is the world's largest and foremost organization of public relations professionals with more than 22,000 public relations and communications professionals, in addition to more than 10,000 university and college students through the Public Relations Student Society of America (PRSSA).

PRSA provides professional development, sets standards of excellence and upholds principles of ethics for its members. We also advocate for greater understanding and adoption of public relations services, and act as one of the industry's leading voices on pivotal business and professional issues.

The Oklahoma City Chapter serves Oklahoma City and the surrounding areas including western and southwestern Oklahoma. The Chapter consists of more than 150 dedicated professionals who practice public relations for corporations, public relations firms, government agencies, health and medical entities, nonprofit and other professional organizations.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Oklahoma City Chapter of the Public Relations Society of America will award two merit-based scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 to be used during the 2020-2021 academic year. Funds will be disbursed in the fall 2020 semester.

QUALIFICATIONS

To qualify for scholarship, you must be:

- A PRSSA member in good standing
- Pursuing a public relations degree full-time (enrolled in at least 12 hours)
- A sophomore or junior (or a senior planning to be in school for an additional year) at a four-year Oklahoma college or university
- Scholarship selection will be based on aptitude, interest in the public relations field, academic performance and demonstration of community service. The recipient will be notified in October.

INSTRUCTIONS

Thoroughly complete the attached application, type or print clearly, and include:

- Your most recent college transcript.
- Two letters of recommendation from people who have witnessed your academic, professional communications, leadership or community experience.
- List of community, school and internship activities, including start and finish dates, officer or committee positions held and any community or academic awards.
- A statement of no more than 300 words explaining why you are applying for this scholarship (i.e. why you are studying public relations, your goals for after graduation, etc.) and your involvement in PRSSA.

Applications must be received by 5 p.m. on Sept. 30, 2020. Applications received after Sept. 30 will not be considered.
